INDIAN CREEK STUDENT WINS COUNTY SPELLING BEE: Congratulations to Natasha Freund from Indian Creek Middle School for winning the DeKalb County Spelling Bee in the 25<sup>th</sup> round. The final word that she spelled correctly was “justaposition”. This event was the longest the county spelling bee has gone in the seven years that the regional office of education has been involved. Annie Glidden Road in DeKalb for children to be evaluated and paperwork started to be seen at Shriners Hospitals, where there is never an expense for patients to receive care.

D.U.I. SIMULATION: On Friday, April 30, 2010 the student body and faculty/staff of Indian Creek High School will witness a simulation and informational event regarding driving under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. The event will begin at 8:45 a.m. and last until approximately 11:15 a.m. at the high school. The event is a collaborative effort involving hospitals, the DeKalb County Sheriff's Department, the fire departments of Shabbona and Waterman, the DeKalb County Coroner's office, the REACT helicopter services and Indian Creek High School.

The day will begin with the simulation occurring in the rear parking area of the high school. The simulation is a staged re-creation of a drunk driving accident involving ICHS students. Following the staged accident, the various emergency units will arrive at ICHS with their sirens going and act as if an actual accident has occurred. (For example, an ICHS student will be required to undergo a check by a police officer to determine if

he/she (the student) is under the influence of alcohol). A helicopter will land, if their schedule allows, to transport “injured students”. After completing the check, the student will be arrested, handcuffed, and taken to jail. Other students involved in the staged accident will be removed from the damaged car by means of the “Jaws of Life” – a mechanical cutting instrument that removes the entire top of a car. Finally, an ICHS student will play the part of a young person who is killed as a result of injuries sustained in the accident. This student will be pronounced dead by the county coroner.

Upon completion of the simulation, the student body and faculty/staff members will move inside to the gym where several emergency services professionals will provide information about drunk driving accidents. Several of the speakers have personally experienced tragedy to their lives due to another person’s decision to drive while under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

The students, faculty/staff of Indian Creek High School are extending a sincere “thank you” to all of the emergency services personnel who will give so graciously of their time and talents to make this event a reality. We recognize these exceptional and tremendously caring people for their efforts to provide knowledge and practices regarding safe behaviors to all of our lives. The community of Indian Creek High School is so very fortunate to be served by these individuals.

Very Important Prairie State Achievement Examination Information for Juniors and their Parents/Guardians

March 16, 2010

Dear Parents/Guardians:

***On April 28 and 29, 2010 Indian Creek High School will conduct the mandated state achievement testing of our junior class.*** In the interest of providing accurate accountability of our educational program, it is important that we have an accurate portrayal of their academic achievement. Administrators and teachers carefully study the testing results each year to help determine needed changes. ***We would like to make you aware of the testing dates, so that you can encourage your student to put forth their best effort to provide us with valid test scores.***

Wednesday and Thursday, April 28 and 29, 2010 juniors will take the Prairie State Achievement Examination. ***On Wednesday, all juniors will take the ACT assessment, the college entrance exam most often used in the Midwest. On Thursday, state testing in the area of Science will be administered, along with employment skill-based tests in Applied Mathematics and Reading for Information. This required two day exam is designed to be a comprehensive evaluation of all students in Illinois public high schools prior to their graduation. According to state mandate, students who do not complete this test risk delaying their graduation from high school.*** Also, the results of the two-day assessment will be included on the student's permanent high school transcript.

On Wednesday, April 28, 2010, ***all juniors will be required to arrive at school by 7:20 a.m.*** The majority of students and selected staff members will then be transported to Kishwaukee Community College to take the exam. The remaining students will remain at the high school to complete their testing. These students and their parents have been notified. All students will have lunch at school and will complete their day as normal. ***IVVC students will be dismissed to go home at the approximately 1:45 if they provide their own transportation.*** Regular district transportation will be available at 3:10 for students who need it. ***Please be aware of any extracurricular commitments your student has and the subsequent schedule of those events.***

On Thursday, April 29, 2010 we will follow the same arrival schedule, ***all juniors, unless we experience uncooperativeness and discipline problems, will be dismissed for the day after the completion of the tests if they provide their own transportation. We anticipate the dismissal to be at approximately 12:30 p.m.*** Those students who do not have their own transportation will attend class and follow the same plan as Wednesday. ***Again, please be aware of any extracurricular commitments your student has and the subsequent schedule of those events.***

Your cooperation is greatly appreciated and you can help by encouraging your student to do their best on these upcoming tests. ***One recommended activity would be to review the Student PS&E preparation packets and parent brochure with your students. These were distributed along with this letter, in the U.S. History classes.*** Other activities for the students immediately prior to the test are to get a good night's sleep, eat a good breakfast, and arrive with a positive attitude. ***Please be reminded that all electronic devices (I.e., cell phones, pagers, ipods, MP3 players, digital cameras and video recorders) are strictly prohibited in the testing area. A student found in possession of an electronic device will have his/her score voided.*** Please contact either Mrs. Montgomery or Mr. Farnsworth at the high school if you have a question.
