Overview of testing at ICHS

September

Illinois Consumer Proficiency Examination- grades 9-12 (including seniors not enrolled in resource management). Examination can be taken once per school year.

October

NEWA/MAP- grades 9-10

Individual on-line testing in reading, mathematics, and language arts

PSAT/NMSQT- grade 11

PSAE Senior Retakes including ACT on Saturday prior to PSAE retakes

ACT testing on site at ICHS

November

EXPLORE- grade 9

PLAN- grade 10

These tests are part of the scope and sequence of ACT. They generate not only test scores and benchmarks for work and college readiness, but also career inventories to help ICHS students make informed decisions about the world of work.

January

Illinois Consumer Proficiency Examination- grades 9-11

Examination can be taken once per school year

April

PSAE- grade 11

Requirement for graduation mandated by state of Illinois

NWEA/MAP- grades 9-10

Individual online testing in reading, mathematics, and language arts

May

Make-up testing for PSAE- grade 11

AP Examinations if we have students enrolled in AP courses through Long distance providers or IVHS examinations such as National Latin Exam

June

ACT testing on site at ICHS
