Part A: Complete a community service project with a local organization that is a minimum in two hours of length.

Part B: Using a visual aid that includes pictures of class members performing the service project, give a presentation to fellow class members that demonstrate the following details:

- 1) The name and short history of the organization.
- 2) The organization's mission statement or purpose to the community.
- 3) The specific service project participated in and how it fulfilled the mission statement or purpose.
- 4) The benefits of this project to community members.
- 5) The benefits of this project to the participants.
- 6) Sign statement of student participation from organization's representative.

Part C: Write a personal narrative that answers the following questions. You may use I, but remember that sentence structure, grammar, and punctuation will be graded. Papers must have a MLA heading, be typed, be doubled spaced, and be 1 ½ to 2 pages in length.

- 1) What does service to mean to you?
- 2) Explain what personal satisfaction you receive from service opportunities.
- 3) Why are service organizations necessary in a society?
- 4) How does service help the following groups: participants, recipients, and communities as a whole?
- 5) Discuss different ways government (local, state, and federal) should assist service organizations in meeting their mission statement. If you do not believe they have an obligation to help, explain why.
- 6) Specifically explain how the economy impacts the success or failure of service organizations and their efforts?
- 7) How should the education system promote and foster increased community service by students?
